How is the course assessed?

Component 1 Portfolio (60%)

A major practical portfolio and outcome based on the student's topic of choice, a question that is to be answered through visual and written analysis.

1,000 - 3,000 word essay about the portfolio project.

Component 2 Externally Set Assignment (40%)

An assignment based on one of a selection of set themes

Part 1: Preparatory Study Period – commencing in the Spring term of year 13

Part 2: Sustained Focus Work – 15 hours
