Years 12/13: Visit to Bethlem Museum of the Mind, Beckenham – Psychology Tuesday 26 February 2019

To help bring the subject of psychology to life, a visit has been organised to the Bethlem Museum of the Mind. With the adjoining hospital being formerly known as Bedlam Asylum, the museum offers exhibits on the history of mental illness and its treatment through the ages and holds extensive archives of patient records that are partially available to the public.

This visit is a full-day trip, so your son/daughter will need to arrive at Braintree Sixth Form by 8.45am. We will be taken by coach, door to door. On our arrival at the museum, we will be given a presentation by the management, followed by a Q&A session with a working clinician, then time in the archives and the museum. We will depart early afternoon, arriving back at Braintree Sixth Form at approximately 2.45pm, and students will be free to go home after we return to Braintree Sixth Form.

The cost of this visit for each student is £20. Spaces are limited and will be reserved on a first-come first-served basis.

If you would like your son/daughter to take part in the visit, please complete the attached permission slip and consent form and return to Braintree Sixth Form in an envelope clearly labelled "Bethlem Museum of the Mind, Beckenham - Psychology" with the student's name and tutor group by Tuesday 12 February 2019. To pay by ParentPay, please indicate on the reply slip; cheques should be made payable to Notley High School & Braintree Sixth Form and the student's name and "Bethlem Museum of the Mind, Beckenham - Psychology" should be written on the reverse.
