AS Results

AS results are published on Thursday 17 August and can be collected from the library between 11.00am and 12.00pm. For those that have sat GCSE examinations this year, these results will be available for collection on 24 August between 9.00-11.00am. If you are unable to attend to collect your results then you can send a friend or relative but the person collecting the results must have photo ID with them and a letter of consent signed by the student. This can also be emailed directly to our Exams Officer at natalie.musson@notleyhigh.com. Without this consent, results will not be issued. If there is no-one available to collect your results, you can also send a SAE to Mrs Musson and she will post the results home for you.

On collection of your AS results, students should ensure that they see a member of the Braintree Sixth Form leadership team before they leave to confirm progression into Year 13 and to confirm subject arrangements for next year.

Lockers

As we approach the end of term, students must also ensure that they remove the locks from their lockers and also empty their lockers to allow for these to be cleaned over the summer. Lockers will then be made available to students on their return in September.
